Bikes and Scooters at School

With the beautiful weather finally here, students are riding to school on their bikes and scooters. To ensure our students safety it is required that all students wear helmets when riding. If students do not have a helmet on while riding, the bike or scooter will be held until a parent/guardian can pick it up. We ask for your assistance in keeping our students safe!

Some additional bike safety tips:

- **Wear a Properly Fitted Helmet.**
- **Check Your Equipment**—before riding, inflate tires properly and check that your breaks work.
- **See and Be Seen.** Whether daytime, dawn, dusk, foul weather, or at night, you need to be seen by others. Wear reflectors or bright clothing when riding.
- **Watch for and Avoid Road Hazards.** Be on the lookout for hazards such as potholes, broken glass, gravel, puddles, leaves, and dogs.


